

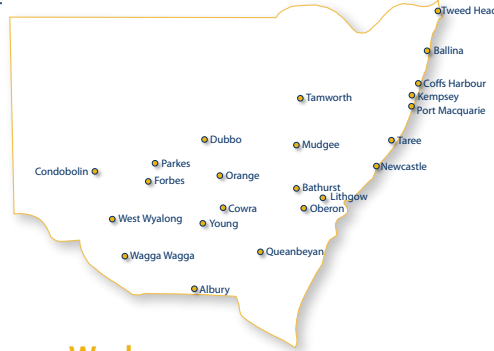


Central West Community College

Our team of 170 staff and 130 trainers and assessors deliver a diverse range of programs and services through seven service areas:

- Training Services** – pre-employment and vocational training opportunities for people wanting to enter or re-enter the workforce
- Business Services** – training for employees and customised consultancy services for employers to upskill their workforce
- Job Services** – helping individual jobseekers to participate in employment as well as assisting local employers and industry to find skilled labour
- Australian Apprenticeships Services** – coordinated support for employers and their trainees and apprentices to establish their apprenticeship programs including administration of employer incentive funding and Apprentice benefits
- Industry Services** – workforce development and specialised training for the agrifoods, community services and mining industries
